The Six Traits of Effective Writing

<u>Ideas</u> – Good writing has clear ideas, a purpose, or focus. It should have specific ideas and details.

<u>Organization</u> – Writing should have a beginning, middle, and ending and be well organized and easy to follow.

<u>Voice</u> – Your writing should connect with your audience, fit your purpose for writing, and reveal your voice.

<u>Word Choice</u> – Good writing has specific nouns and verbs and strong words that deliver the writer's message.

<u>Sentence Fluency</u> – Sentences should vary in length, with a variety of sentence beginnings. The writing should flow smoothly from sentence to sentence.

<u>Conventions</u> – Strong writing is edited for grammar, punctuation, capitalization, and spelling so the writer's ideas are easily understood.
